

## **Problem Properties**

The property could have a significant detrimental impact to the surrounding area such as noise violations, property deterioration, or pose risks to tenants and surrounding residents such as safety issues from development of the property, ongoing illegal activity or criminal activities (all criminal activity should be reported to EPS, and this reporting mechanism is not a substitute for reporting to EPS).

Through an integrated and holistic approach, members of the Problem Property Action Team and Residential Inspection Safety Compliance team work to achieve compliance with municipal, provincial and federal legislation at high-risk properties to reduce overall risk in the community. This helps foster safer and better-connected communities in Edmonton.
