- Woodvale Community League (WCL) Membership cost: \$25.00 (family or single)
- Valid from Sept 1, 2017 to Aug 31, 2018; on sale now at the WCL office
- WCL office is located on the 2nd floor of the Woodvale Facility on the Millwood's Golf Course (4540-50 St NW)

- Benefits:
 - Free skating at any outdoor city rink (with your community league membership skate tag)
 - Green Shack use in the summer
 - Ski Night on Feb 23, 2019 (check for details and costs at www.woodvale.org closer to the event)
 - At Strathcona Science Park
 - Cineplex theatre tickets:
 - Up to 8 Adult tickets may be purchased monthly at a cost of \$9.00 each (theatre price approx \$12.50 +)
 - With the purchase of a WCL membership the first 8 tickets are available for \$7.00 each
 - Tickets are available only at the WCL office
 - Prices subject to change should Cineplex increase prices to us

 - Effective January 2017, discounts on purchases of City of Edmonton Leisure, Sports and Fitness Facilities passes: annual passes and automated monthly passes: both receive 20% discounts; multi-admission passes (5+ visits) receive a 15% discount
 - Cloverdale Paint: show your Community league membership card and mention Edmonton Federation of Community Leagues and receive wholesale pricing at any Edmonton Cloverdale Paint location.
 - University of Alberta:
 - receive 25% discount on Microsoft and Adobe courses through the U of A's Technology Training Centre
 - receive a 10% discount on printing services through Campus Design and Print Solutions
 - receive a 10% discount at U of A bookstore (excluding textbooks).
 - Edmonton Tool Library: free access to library; website: edmontontoolibrary.ca
 - Located in Bellevue Community Hall (7308 112 Avenue NW)
 - hours 6-8 pm Wednesdays and 11 am – 3 pm Saturdays
 - Over 300 items of equipment in inventory; you can borrow up to 8 tools at a time.
 - Tools loaned free of charge for a week at a time and time-period can be extended. No deposit required. There are no additional fees for tools (unless you bring it back late or broken).
 - Woodvale Community league members show current community league membership card and sign paperwork waiver when loaning equipment that is at own risk and to return equipment by time periods set out and in good shape or can be charged additional fees. The Community League is NOT responsible for individuals that loan equipment.
- Other:
 - Community League Executive meetings held on 3rd Tuesday evening of each month (except July) at the Woodvale Facility (on the golf course) at 7:00 PM. The next Annual General Meeting (AGM) is on October 15, 2019.

Did you know what types of items the Woodvale Community League has provided in your area or has done to help others in Edmonton. Support your community and buy a membership!

This is just a partial list of how the Woodvale Community League supports the community.

- Built and operates the Woodvale Facility on the Mill Woods Golf Course
- Built the Activity Centre next to Greenview Park and FREE USAGE is provided to qualifying non-profit groups; current users include the Playschool , Jr. Forest Wardens, Yoga classes, Brownies, Youth Groups.
- Planted the trees and shrubs on the boulevards along 38 Ave from 50 St to 66 St; as well trees were planted in and around both Hillview and Greenview Parks. WCL added additional walkways to complete walking trail system.
- Built basketball courts in Hillview and Greenview Parks.
- Built the Greenview Park Skating Rink.
- Contributed to reshaling the baseball diamonds in Woodvale.
- Provided funding to assist MCARFA in getting the Jackie Parker Spray Park built.
- Provided at least \$150,000 to rebuild each of the 3 playgrounds in Woodvale (in Hillview Park, in Greenview Park and on John Paul 1 School grounds) for a total of over \$496,000. Hillview Park playground was rebuilt in 2014, John Paul 1 playground was rebuilt in 2015 and the playground in Greenview Park was rebuilt in 2017.
- Contributes funding towards the Canada Day Celebrations held in Mill Woods Park on July 1.
- Provided funding on a matching grant basis annually to each of the 3 schools in Woodvale: Greenview, Hillview and John Paul 1. These grants have assisted in the purchase of such things as white boards, lap tops, musical instruments and athletic equipment.
- Contributed to the Mill Woods Seniors Activity Centre (on Hewes Way) and helped with the purchase of a new photocopier for the centre.
- Donated annually to support local charities and programs
- Subsidizes an annual Ski Night at the Strathcona Science Park (next night is Feb 23, 2019 with tickets only \$15 per person with helmets and skis included; prices subject to change).
- Subsidizes an annual golf tournament at Mill Wood's Golf Course for Woodvale Community League members.
- Holds yearly Community League Day celebrations (3rd Saturday in September).
